

JESUS IS PRAYING FOR YOU

Jesus had just instituted the Lord's Supper before leaving for the Garden of Gethsemane; among the disciples was Peter who declared their loyalty to Him, no matter what. Jesus said to Peter: "Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: but I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not." There was danger that Peter would go down beneath the flood of temptation.

In just a matter of hours Peter was swept off his feet because he was in a hostile atmosphere of the judgement hall and heard the words of maid who identified him as a follower of Jesus. He denied his Lord with oaths and curses, but he kept his faith and repented and was restored to his discipleship. After this Peter's faith increased year after year and he was faithful until death. Jesus had prayed for him.

Precious one, in your hour of testing, whether it be of temptation, danger or death, remember that Jesus is praying for you that your faith does not fail in The Daily Walk.
