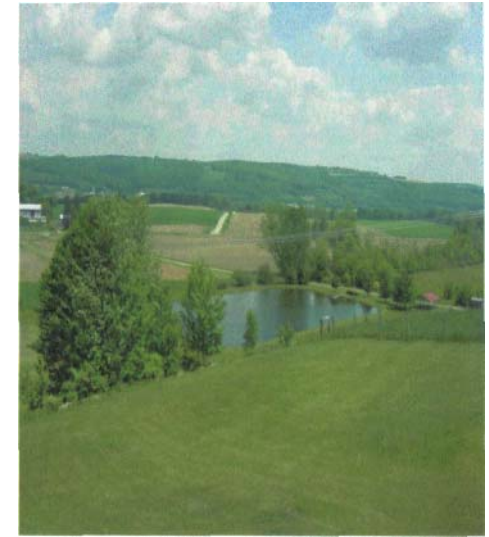
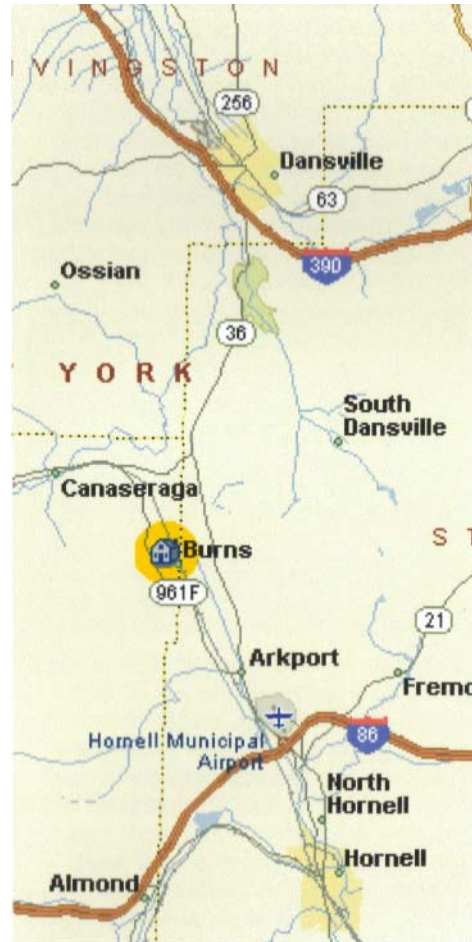

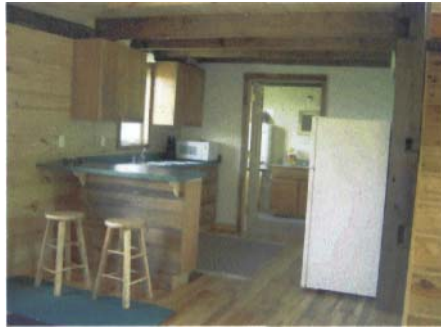

Country Cabin House of REST is located in rural upstate New York, in fact, right in the middle of a working beef and research farm. The cabin is available from mid-April through the end of October. The following will help you know what supplies and equipment are on hand and what will be expected of you. The cabin is a real retreat - no phone and no TV. Cell phone service, however, is available. There are a few table games and as we can, we will add more, so feel free to bring along your own favorites. A small study library has been started and we are actively seeking donations to expand it.



The kitchen has a refrigerator, propane range and small microwave. It is stocked with basic cooking utensils (including a toaster, coffee maker and cooking pots) and dry foodstuffs. For your other grocery needs, Cy's Shurfine Foodmart is just three miles away in Arkport. The cabin has no garbage service, so we ask that you pack your garbage out. There is a recycling center nearby and if you are willing to prepare recyclables as required, we will take care of those for you.



The cabin has two sleeping areas: a small downstairs bedroom with a bunk bed (double on the bottom, single on top), the loft has a queen-sized bed. There are a couple of cots and a queen-sized air bed also available. So that the cabin can be left clean we ask that you bring your own sheets, pillowcases and towels, but if necessary, these are available here. Pillows and blankets are provided. The bathroom has a shower.



Because so many people have severe allergic reactions to pet fur, we cannot allow pets inside the cabin. No alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs are permitted on the premises.

The cabin's main source of energy is solar electricity. Because of this we ask that you plan ahead to be very conservative in your use of it. The system will not support prolonged periods of electric use such as required by crock pots and electric skillets. Hairdryers and electric razors are acceptable. Cell phones and laptop computers may be recharged, but should not be left plugged in once their batteries are fully charged. A backup generator is available if needed.

You may use our pond and picnic area for swimming, boating, fishing or just relaxing. Campfires are permitted with ample care and firewood is available for these. If you are more adventurous, you might enjoy a hike in the woods.
