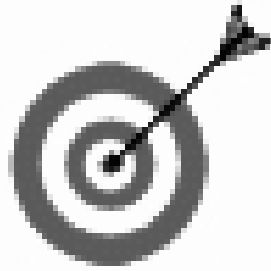
Trevor's political activism began in college where he was strongly involved in grass roots organization. He has focused on civil rights, health care, the environment, housing, higher education and social justice.

EDUCATION

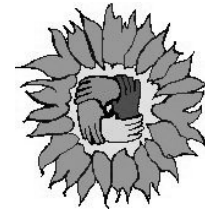
