My name is Trevor Archer and I am running for the New York State Assembly in the 83rd AD. For some, this is an introduction, but to many, this is just another friendly greeting.

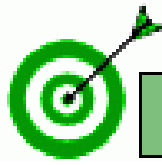

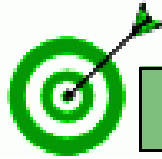
