## What is Music Together®?

Music Together is an innovative approach to early childhood music education. Now being taught nationwide and around the world, the program is based on the premise that all children (and adults, too!) are inherently musical and can achieve basic musical competence, which can be defined as keeping a beat and singing in tune. Music Together believes we are all entitled to truly experience the joy of making music!

Our goal is to nurture your child's natural enthusiasm for music and movement. We sing, dance, rhyme, and play instruments in an informal setting that allows children to develop at their own pace. We also educate parents/caregivers how to better encourage their child's musical growth. This is a non-performance oriented program in which emphasis is based on the learning process itself, rather than the product.

## The Music Together® Way...

**Non- formal Instruction:** Children participate according to their own developmental level. The class experience, reinforced by tape / CD listening and active parent involvement, stimulates learning at home through play.

### **Mixed-Age classes (birth-four):**

Educators have long considered mixed-age groupings to be beneficial, and the MT program is designed with this in mind. Activities focus on adult/child interaction, rather than just child/child interaction, so children of different ages (siblings for example) can enjoy classes together. Music selections are appropriate for children of all ages, and activities are varied to meet each child's abilities.

### **Starting Early...infants:**

Research points to the far-reaching educational value of early musical exposure for infants. Our classes provide the additional benefit of an enriched social environment where infants freely associate with older children and siblings, and older children gain confidence-building experience. In our Regular Mixed-age classes, infants 10 months and under attend free when accompanying a registered older sibling. Plus:we also offer a "Babies Intro Class" for Moms with infants as a way of starting the Musical journey -Together!
