General

1. Open to string players who are students of California ASTA members.
2. Entrants must apply only in their area of residence. If living at school, the school address will be considered as the student's valid residence.
3. Entrants must have participated their ASTA Section's Competition and have been declared eligible by the judges to advance to the State Competition.
4. Sections may submit as many entrants as the judges in their section competitions deem qualified.
5. There are two age divisions: Junior, through age 18 and Senior, 19-25. The cutoff date for the age divisions is the date of the competition.
6. The judges may declare a winner on each instrument in each age division; Violin, Viola, Cello, Bass, Classical Guitar and Harp.
7. Competition winners will be the featured artists in a showcase recital at the California Music Educators Association Conference at the Sacramento Convention Center Sacramento, California March 12, 2010.
Cash awards will be presented at this event.

Repertoire and Performance

1. Two works are required. One piece from the classical or baroque period and one from a contrasting period style. All works must be memorized.
2. Performance may not exceed 15 minutes for junior division or 20 minutes for senior division entrants.
3. Piano accompaniment is required where appropriate.

Application Deadline and Fees

1. Applications and appropriate fees made payable to CAL-ASTA must be postmarked by October 1, 2009. An entrance fee of \$40.00 must accompany each application.
3. A professional accompanist can be provided for a fee of \$35.00 which must be requested and paid for at the time of application. The accompanist will provide a brief pre-performance run-through.
