

Coyote Ugly CATTLE RANCH TRIAL

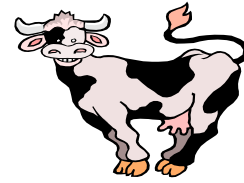
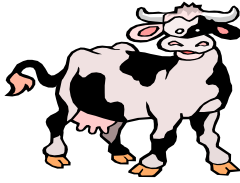

the ranch course is as follows:

You and your dog will enjoy an early morning horseback ride as you head out into a 600+ acre pasture to find your cattle. Your mission is to locate and gather (from a grazing herd of 50-60 cows) 10 (ten) head and bring them back to the corrals. Once your 10 (ten) head are in the corrals, the Judge will pick 3 for loading and the other 7 (seven) need to be gate sorted and moved into the front corral.

The remaining 3 head need to be shipped and your task is to take them down the alleyway and put them thru the lading chute and into the stock trailer. Once you're given the o.k. from the Judge, you will upload the trailer and place the 3 (three) head back with the heard in the front corral. Your mission is completed when your herd is penned up in their new corral having safely survived the dangers of the coyote ugly ranch test. Good Job!

Maximum time allowed is 45 minutes. You must provide your own horse. This course cannot be done on foot.



Technical details:

- 🐾 You will start your gather on horseback in a 600 acre pasture.
- 🐾 Go find and sort out 10 head and bring them to the corrals
- 🐾 put the 10 head into corral #a
- 🐾 The Judge will pick 3 and you must gate sort the remaining 7 head the Judge does not want
- 🐾 move the 7 head into corral #b
- 🐾 take the remaining 3 head and move them down the alleyway and into the loading chute.
- 🐾 from the 8' x 16' loading chute load these 3 head into the trailer
- 🐾 unload the trailer and put the 3 head into corral #b with the other cattle
