



There are three switches,

1. Power Switch

- When the power switch is on, the heating element is activated, heating the water in the boiler to 197° Fahrenheit.

2. Pump Switch

- When the pump switch is on, cold water is pumped into the boiler at 9 bars of pressure (131 psi), forcing the hot water up and into the stand pipe.
- This hot water is forced through the coffee in the filter by the pump pressure.

3. Steam Switch

- When the steam switch is on, the heating element is activated, heating the water in the boiler to 296° Fahrenheit.

When the steam valve is opened, first water is purged and then steam is forced through the valve.
