Rules & General Information

Douglas County residents and visitors are invited to explore our community. This juried exhibition intends to present photographers' perspectives on places and people in and around Douglasville and Douglas County.

Purpose:

This exhibit promotes an appreciation of photography as an art, enabling photographers to exhibit their work and encouraging local citizens to enjoy a variety of high-quality photographs of their community. The Cultural Arts Center, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, has exhibited works by more than 1,000 artists since it was established in 1986.

Juror:

Susan Todd-Raque, photography historian and co-founder of *Atlanta Celebrates Photography*

Eligibility:

All artists 18 years old or older are eligible to submit any original photographic image, whether created by traditional, digitally or through alternative processes. Any enhanced image must begin as an original photographic work by the artist submitting it for consideration. Accepted art works must remain on display for the entire exhibition.

Limitations:

All works must be framed and equipped for hanging. Work must have been completed within the last two years.

Submission:

Art works can be submitted as slides or digital images (jpeg, tif or psd) for jurying. Slides must be 2"x2" standard size. Oversize mounts and glass slides will not be accepted. Please indicate the top of the work with an arrow on each slide.

Whether in slide form or as digital images, please include the following information:

1. Name of Artist
2. Title of Work
3. Medium
4. Size
5. Price (please include insurance value if the work is identified as "NFS")
6. Date

Work that differs considerably from the original entry will be disqualified.

Entrants must complete the entry form and notification form attached. Slides will be returned to the artist. Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of slides submitted.

Entry & Fee:

A non-refundable entry fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) for current CAC, Sweetwater Camera Club and Douglas County Arts Guild members; thirty dollars (\$30) for non-members, qualifies the artist to submit three works and will be used to promote the show. Submission does not guarantee acceptance. Submit with your completed entry form, which is available at www.artsdouglas.org.

Sales will be encouraged; 25% commission will be taken on all work sold with the exception of the purchase award.

The Cultural Arts Center will take every precaution against damage or theft, but artists are responsible for their own insurance.
