Dear Vendor,

We hope your 2008 season was successful. We invite you to join us for our 2009 Meredith Dairy Fest, held this year on Saturday, June 13th and Sunday, June 14th, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., rain or shine.

The Dairy Fest will, as in prior years, be held on the Meridale Farms field in the Town of Meredith, Delaware County, New York. Events will include exhibits, demonstrations, and sales of dairy products as well as craft, antique, collectible, and new merchandise vendors. There will be our ever-popular Cow Plop Bingo, wine and cheese tasting and sales, music and other entertainment, and a variety of food.

All vendors are responsible for bringing any tables or chairs they may require. This site is known to be windy, so please plan to prepare your booth accordingly. Vendors may set up Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. or Saturday morning, starting at 6:30 a.m. New York State requires tax Numbers. **THERE ARE TO BE NO DOGS, RAFFLES, GENERATORS, OR FIREWORKS (INCLUDING POPPERS AND SMOKE BOMBS).** The Dairy Fest Committee reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of items sold.

Security will be provided from 6:00 p.m. on June 12th to 5:00 p.m. on June 14th. However, the event host assumes no responsibility for theft, damage, or loss of an exhibitor's wares or display materials.

Fee payment is required with your application. Vendor fee is for two days and vendors are expected to remain open during the **entire Dairy Fest**. Vehicle spaces are extremely limited and are intended only for vendors who use their vehicle as an integral part of their display. In order to accommodate as many as possible, no one vendor may have more than two spaces.

On-site camping by vendors may be permitted with prior approval of the vendor committee. There are no water, sewer, or electrical hook-ups available. There will be portable toilets on-site.

The Dairy Fest is advertised throughout the Northeast with radio ads, print media, flyers, placemats placed in dining facilities, and our website, www.dairyfest.com.
