

DANCE RUBRIC

An “A” student will consistently:

- a) attend class regularly & on time and always come properly dressed to dance with no jewelry
- b) participate fully in technical activities with enthusiasm, quality & correct etiquette
- c) show excitement for projects, go beyond the required work and complete all assignments on time and with quality
- d) take direction and correction with a positive attitude
- e) participate in class discussions with meaningful contributions
- f) identify and perform movement sequences and skills, demonstrating continuous improvement in technical capabilities
- g) always maintain healthy habits for their mind/body/spirit
- h) provide quality performances for an audience, teacher, and peers
- i) be in communication with instructors, other adults and peers
- j) attend all mandatory events and rehearsals

A “B” student will frequently:

- a) attend class and come dressed to dance
- b) participate fully in technical activities
- c) show enthusiasm for projects, go beyond the required work, and complete all class assignments
- d) take some direction and correction
- e) actively participate in class discussions
- f) identify and perform movement sequences and skills and improve technical capabilities
- g) maintain healthy habits for their mind/body/spirit
- h) perform for an audience, teachers, and peers
- i) use good communication with instructors, other adults and peers
- j) attend most mandatory events and rehearsals

A “C” student will:

- a) attend most classes but be improperly dressed for class at times
- b) attempt to participate in technical activities
- c) turn projects in with minimum requirements
- d) take direction and correction with some sensitivity
- e) attempt to contribute to class discussions
- f) identify and perform movement sequences
- g) somewhat maintain healthy habits for their mind/body/spirit
- h) perform with inconsistencies for an audience, teachers, and peers
- i) occasionally communicate with instructors, other adults, and peers
- j) occasionally attend mandatory events and rehearsals

A “D” student will:

- a) demonstrate inconsistent attendance and often dress improperly for class
- b) fail to complete most technical activities
- c) turn in incomplete or poor-quality projects
- d) take direction and correction with a defensive attitude
- e) undermine class discussions with disruptions
- f) have problems with movement sequences
- g) be inconsistent with healthy habits for their mind/body/spirit
- h) perform without confidence or concentration
- i) be inconsistent in their communication with teachers, adults, and peers
- j) be inconsistent in attending mandatory events and rehearsals

An “F” student will:

- a) show inconsistent attendance and seldom dress for class
- b) fail to complete any technical activities
- c) seldom turn in projects, or complete them incorrectly
- d) not take direction and correction at all
- e) constantly undermine class discussions with disruptions
- f) fail to perform movement sequences
- g) fail to show healthy habits for mind/body/spirit
- h) fails to perform
- i) fail to communicate with teachers, adults, and peers
- j) fail to attend mandatory events and rehearsals
