# \$1,500 Book Prize

RSAP encourages submissions from authors as well as from academic presses

Submissions are not limited to work that has utilized electronic databases

Winners are encouraged to attend ALA 2011

For the author of the best monograph on American periodicals published by an academic press during 2010. (Books published during 2009 that were not submitted to our last competition may also be considered.)

The prize will be awarded at the American Literature Association (ALA) conference in Boston, MA, May 26–29, 2011.

Books will be judged by a peer review of three scholars chosen by the RSAP Advisory Board.

Applicants should submit a registration form (see details, below) and THREE hard copies of their work to Craig Monk, Office of the Dean of Arts and Science, University of Lethbridge, 4401 University Drive West, Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada, T1K 3M4 by December 15, 2010. The winner and up to two honorable mentions will be notified by February 1, 2011 and will be recognized at an RSAP-sponsored panel/event at ALA.

Applicants to the EBSCOhost–RSAP Book Prize must be current members of RSAP when they submit their books.
