SUBJECT: GROUP NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

By law we are required to follow the strictures of DOD Directives 5500.11, 1020.1 and Air Force Instruction 36-2707.

Under CAP Regulations we follow Regulation 52-10 regarding the Cadet Protection Program. Additionally CAPR 39-2 regulates the Civil Air Patrol non-discrimination policy: "no member shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or subjected to discrimination in any CAP program or activity on the basis of age, sex, religion, race, color, national origin or disability (formerly handicap)".
