ORGANIZATION OF CIVIL AIR PATROL

CAP Regulation 20-1, 29 May 2000, is supplemented as follows:

ADDED. Section D. 15 In the absence of the group commander and the deputy commander, temporary command will pass to the highest ranking squadron commander in the group. In addition the executive officer, the emergency services officer, and the operations officer may activate the group in an emergency.

ADDED. Part III. SENIOR MEMBER POSITION DESCRIPTIONS
Squadron Commander

Attends the Southeast Group Council meetings as scheduled or ensures a unit representative attends.

ADDED. Part III. SENIOR MEMBER POSITIONS DESCRIPTIONS
Executive Officer

The Executive Officer is the manager of the group staff positions with the exception of the inspector and the safety officer. The Executive Officer acts as the commander of the group unit senior flight.

ADDED. Part III. SENIOR MEMBER POSITIONS DESCRIPTIONS
Internal Emergency Services Officer

The Internal Emergency Services Officer is responsible for monitoring and tracking the ES rating of the group unit members.

ADDED. Part III. SENIOR MEMBER POSITIONS DESCRIPTIONS
Southeast Group Council.

The unit commanders of the Southeast Wisconsin Group are members of the Southeast Group Council. They are advisors to the group commander. They will provide advice and consent on all group supplements before they are implemented in the group.

ADDED. Part IV. CADET MEMBERS POSITIONS
Cadet Advisory Council

The Southeast Group CAC has been approved by WICC. The Group CAC will operate under the supervision of the group cadet programs officer and advise the group commander on issues concerning cadets. The CAC may also be tasked for specific projects concerning cadets when such tasking promotes the learning experiences of the cadet program.
