Personnel - General

CIVIL AIR PATROL MEMBERSHIP

CAP Regulation 39-2, dated 16 June 2004, is supplemented as follows:

ADDED. Section B. 1-12 c. In accordance with Wisconsin Wing policy on Electronic Records and Reports dated 31 January 2003 and the NHQ policy on Paperwork Reduction Initiatives dated 24 January 2004, CAPF2a's are specifically identified as forms which can be stored electronically. Duty assignment and changes shall be made using the Unit Duty Assignments feature in WMU and using Duty Assignments feature in NHQ e-Services using these electronic personnel authorizations. *Assignments made in these electronic tools can give WMU and e-Services authorizations that members need to accomplish their duties.* Also, assignments to committees, boards, etc., or special one-time duty assignments do not require a CAPF 2a, but may be reflected in the WMU's electronically published personnel authorizations.
