

***BAND OF FRIENDS***  
*Duple Minor Longways Improper*  
*Historical English Style*

- A1            First couple lead down through second couple, cast back to place, and do a half figure 8 around the second couple.
- A2            Second couple lead up through first couple, cast back to place, and do a half figure 8 around the first couple.
- B1     1-4     All fall back with Nbr; come forward and pass through, into . . .  
      5-8     RHA once around.
- B2     1-4     CORNER CROSSINGS: M change on the corners; then W change on the corners.
- 5-6     Second couple (now above) cast down, as first couple moves up and casts down into . .
- 7-12    Mirror-image gypsies with Nbr, (R shoulder in W's line, L shoulder in M's line), until second couple can cross up to new places and first couple can go straight across the set to new places (and get ready to lead down again).
