LEMON LAW FINAL REPAIR DEMAND

Dear Manufacturer Representative:

I believe that my vehicle is a "lemon" under the New Jersey Lemon Law (N.J.S.A. 56:12-29 et seq.). I am hereby making a written demand for relief under the Lemon Law.

I purchased/leased the above referenced vehicle and have returned same for a recurring defects. The vehicle has been returned at least two (2) times to repair the same defect and/or has been in the repair shop for greater than 20 days. The defect in the vehicle is still not corrected. The first attempt to repair was within 18,000 miles and 2 years of the vehicle's purchase.

My vehicle is currently experiencing the following defects:

Since the listed defects are substantial and impair the use, value or safety of my vehicle, I am hereby allowing you one final opportunity to repair my vehicle. If these repairs are not completed within 10 calendar days of receipt of this letter, I am entitled to a refund and a return of costs and fees. Contact me of the date and time to return my vehicle for repair and when a loaner vehicle will be available.
