

Privacy Policy

Commitment to Online Security

At present, Knowledge Empowerment does not collect billing information. If this changes in the future, any billing information will be encrypted in all instances. In addition, billing information will not be shared with outside persons or entities except whenever necessary to process a requested transaction.

Personal Information that Knowledge Empowerment May Collect Online

Computer Tracking and Cookies
