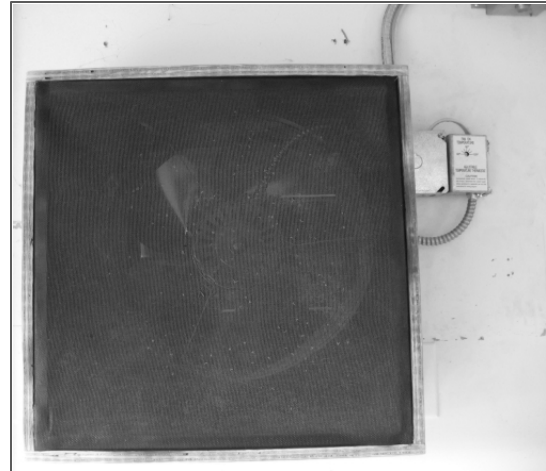


Attention: These are simply ideas on how I mounted the fan in my garage. Check with a licensed contractor before attempting anything similar and check all local building and safety codes. Do not attempt without professional advice. Do not run with scissors.

The fan is a standard attic gable fan. To allow it to work in this surface-mount application, a small box was built into the room to support the body of the fan.

The fan is connected with a thermostat, an on-off-switch, and a high-temperature cut-off to avoid problems in case of a fire.



Outside, commercially available movable louvers allow an attractive appearance when the fan is off.
