If the City is interested in having you serve, then you may be required to submit a more detailed application.

If the Board or Commission to which you are appointed has a conflict of interest policy, then you may be required to file a Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests.

Clerk of the Board of Supervisors

Appointment Process

Some positions may require that you attach evidence of your qualifications.

Appointment Process

You may be required to submit a
"Statement of Incompatible Activities
Related to County Duties" and
"Statement of Membership in Nonprofit
Organizations Funded by County"
Form 519.

If appointed, you may be required to file a Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests.
