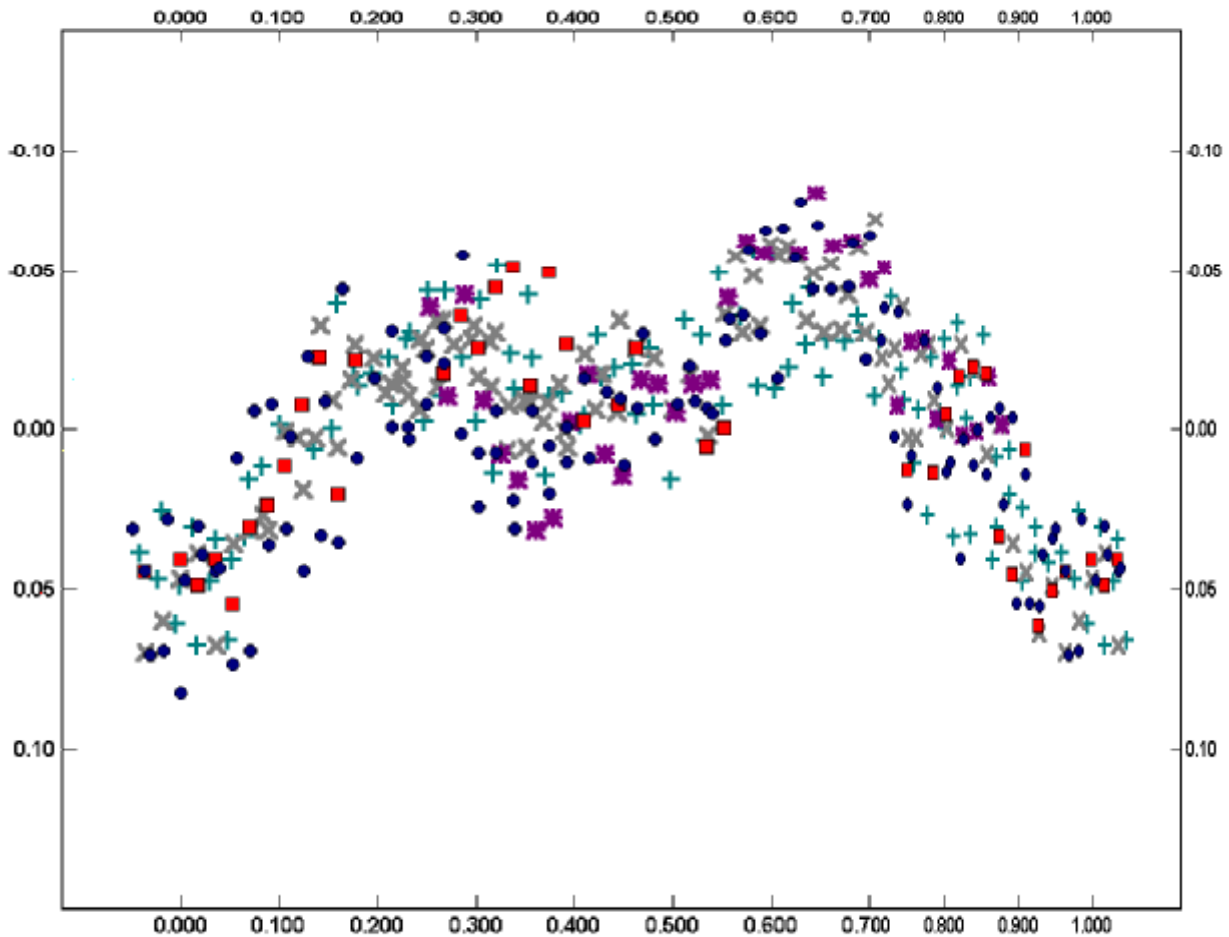

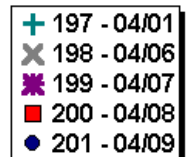

Notes: Riema was discovered 1923 August 13 by K. Reinmuth at Heidelberg. It is named in honor of Johannes Riem (1968-1945) a German astronomer. It is a member of the Hungarias Family and is estimated to be 8 to 1 km in diameter.
