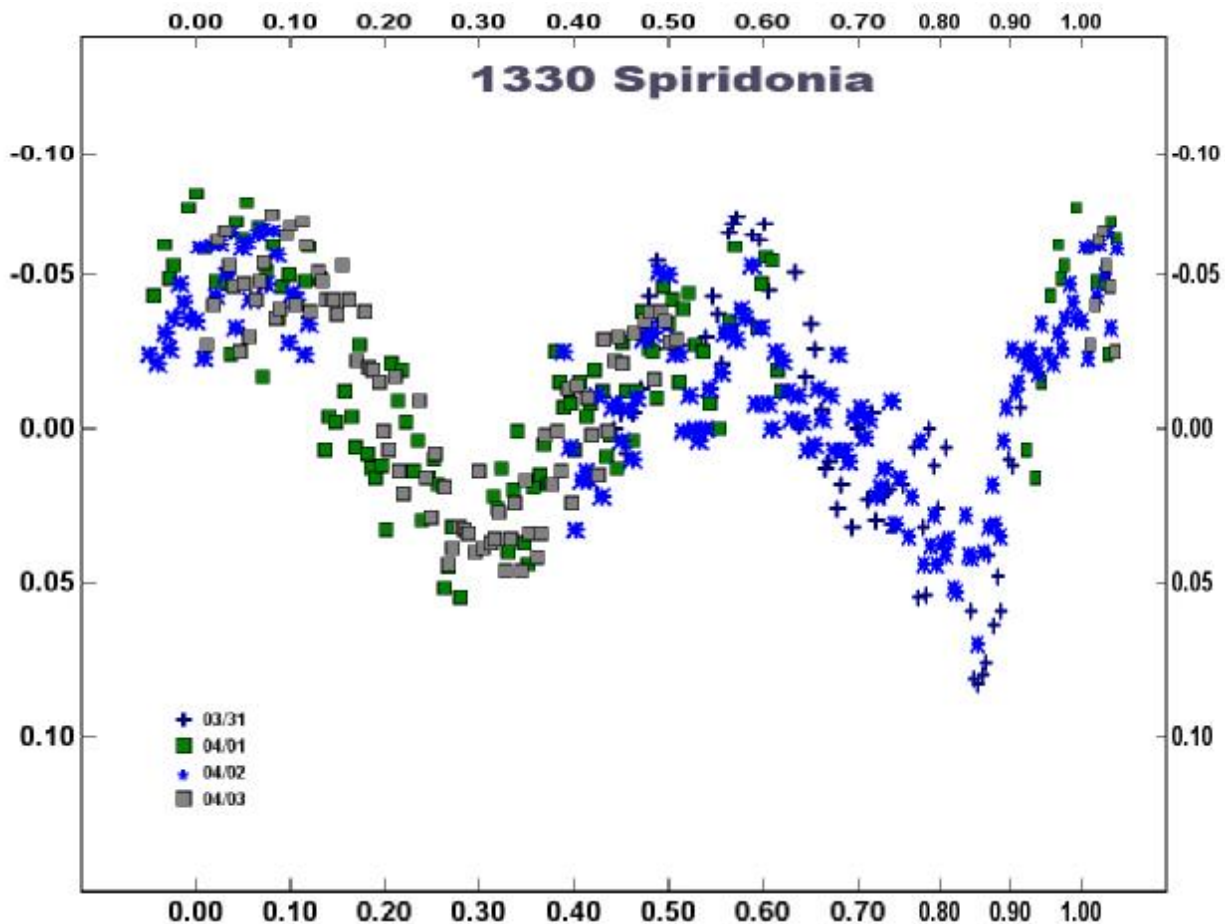


1330 Spiridonia
