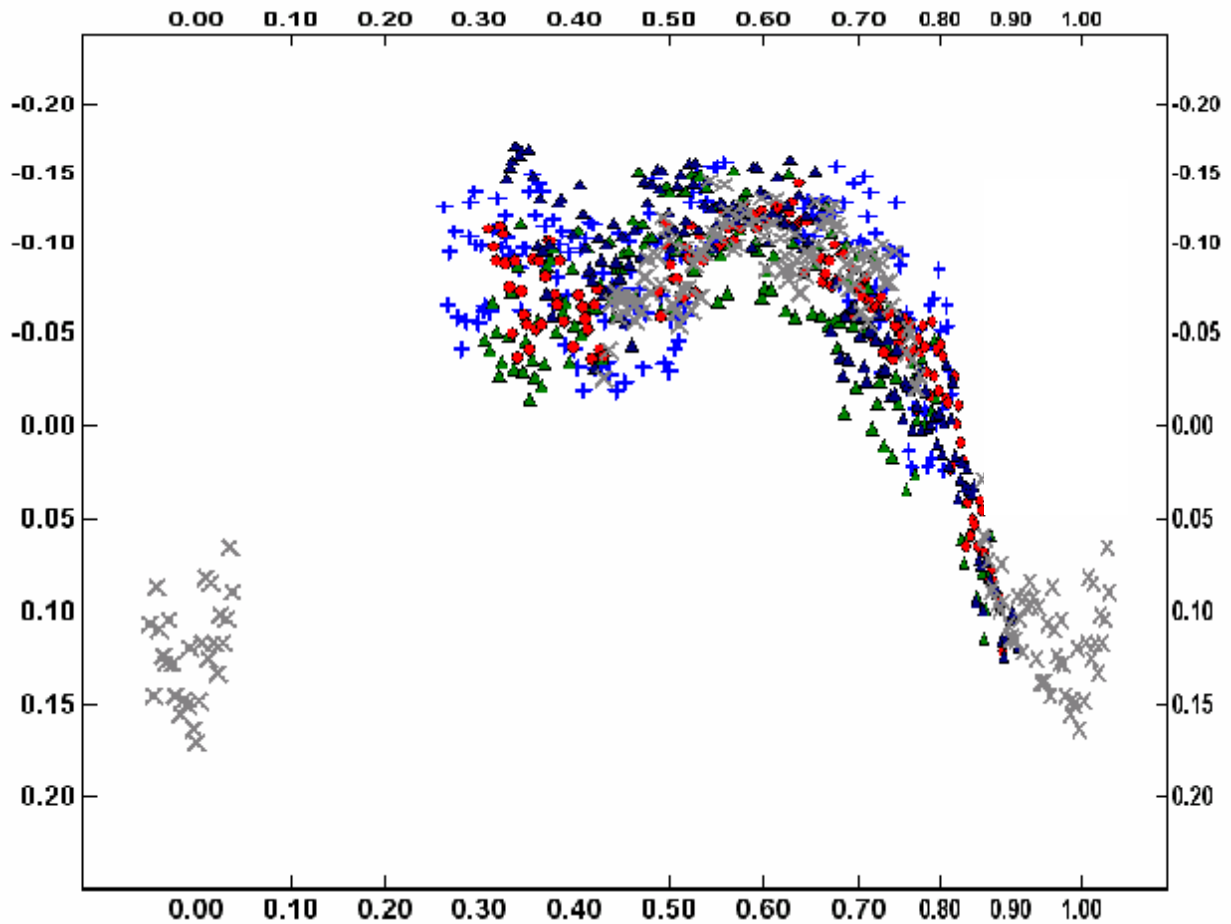

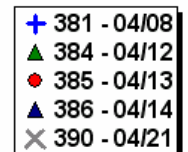

Notes: Discovered January 27, 1935 by E. Delporte at Uccle, Edmee is a Main Belt IIb asteroid with an estimated radius of 14 km. Edmee is named in honor of Mrs. Edmée Chandon who was an astronomer at the Paris Observatory.
