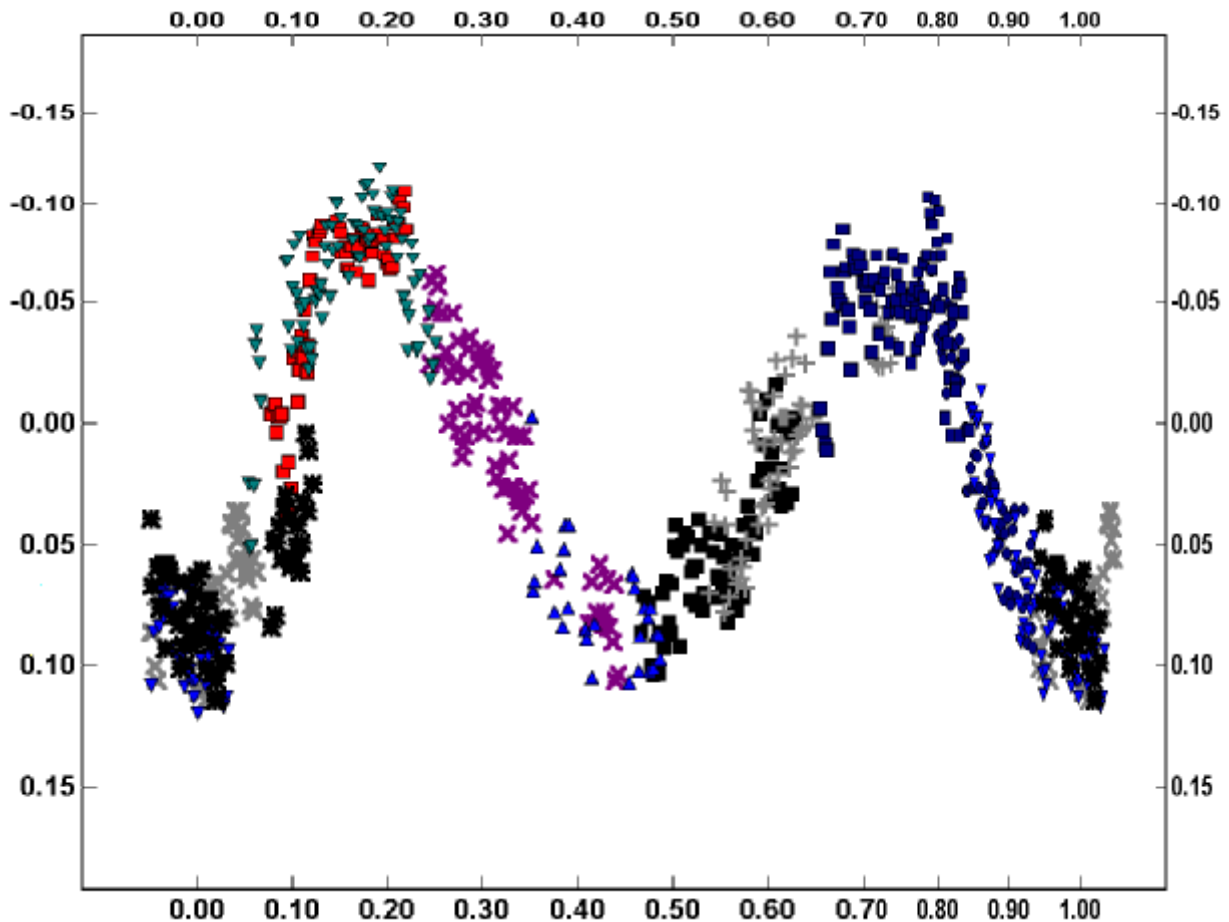


# (1507) Vaasa



Period:  $34.07 \pm .01$

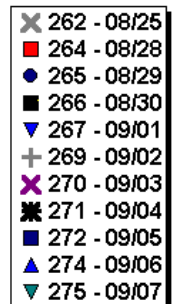

Notes: Vaasa is a Main Belt asteroid discovered on September 12, 1939 by L. Aterma at Utku. It is named for an important Finnish town and port on the Gulf of Bothnia. Based upon its H value, Vaasa is estimated to be 7 to 15 km in diameter.
