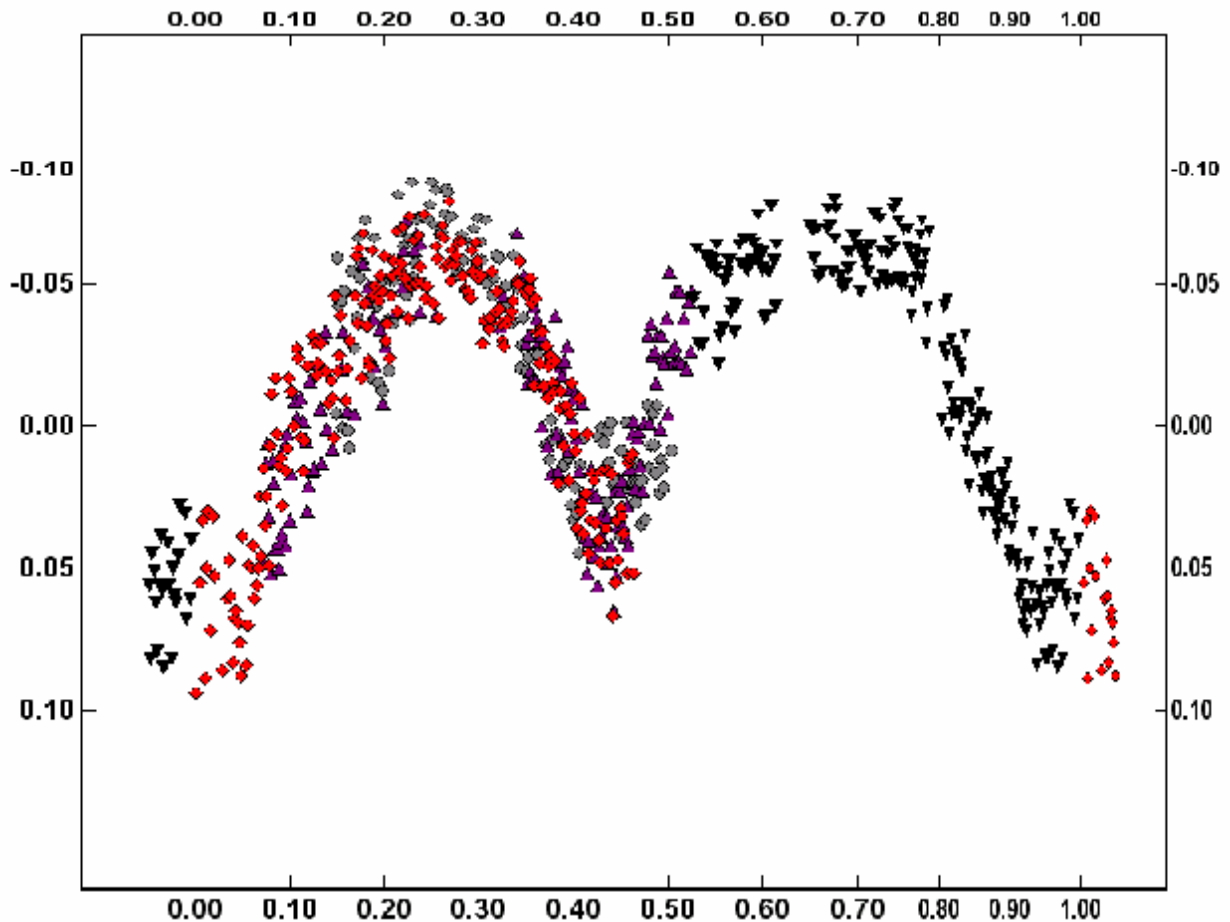

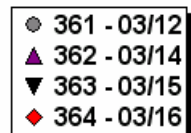

Notes: Discovered April 22, 1941 by Y. Väisälä at Turku, Alikoski is a Main Belt III asteroid with an estimated radius of 34 km. Alikoski is named in honor of Heikki A. Alikoski, assistant to the discoverer from 1937 to 1956. He helped establish the Turku Astronomical-Optical Institute.
