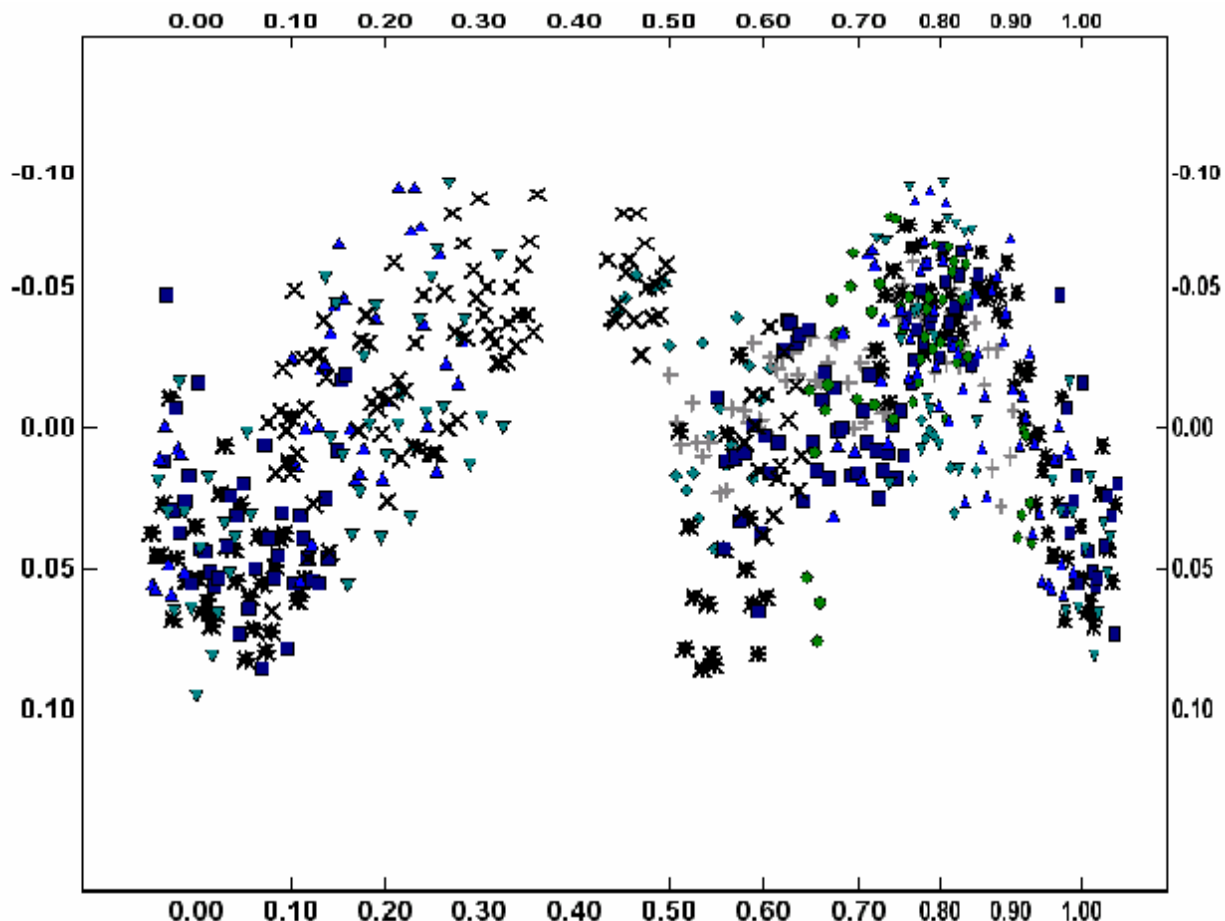


# (2771) Polzunov



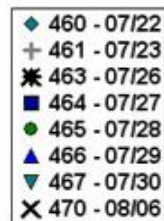

Notes: Polzunov is a Marias Family asteroid discovered on September 26, 1978 by L. V. Zhuravleva at Nauchnyj. It is named for Ivan Ivanovich Polzunov (1728-1766), inventor of the first universal steam-engine in Russia. Based upon its H value, it is estimated to be 11 to 24 km in diameter.
