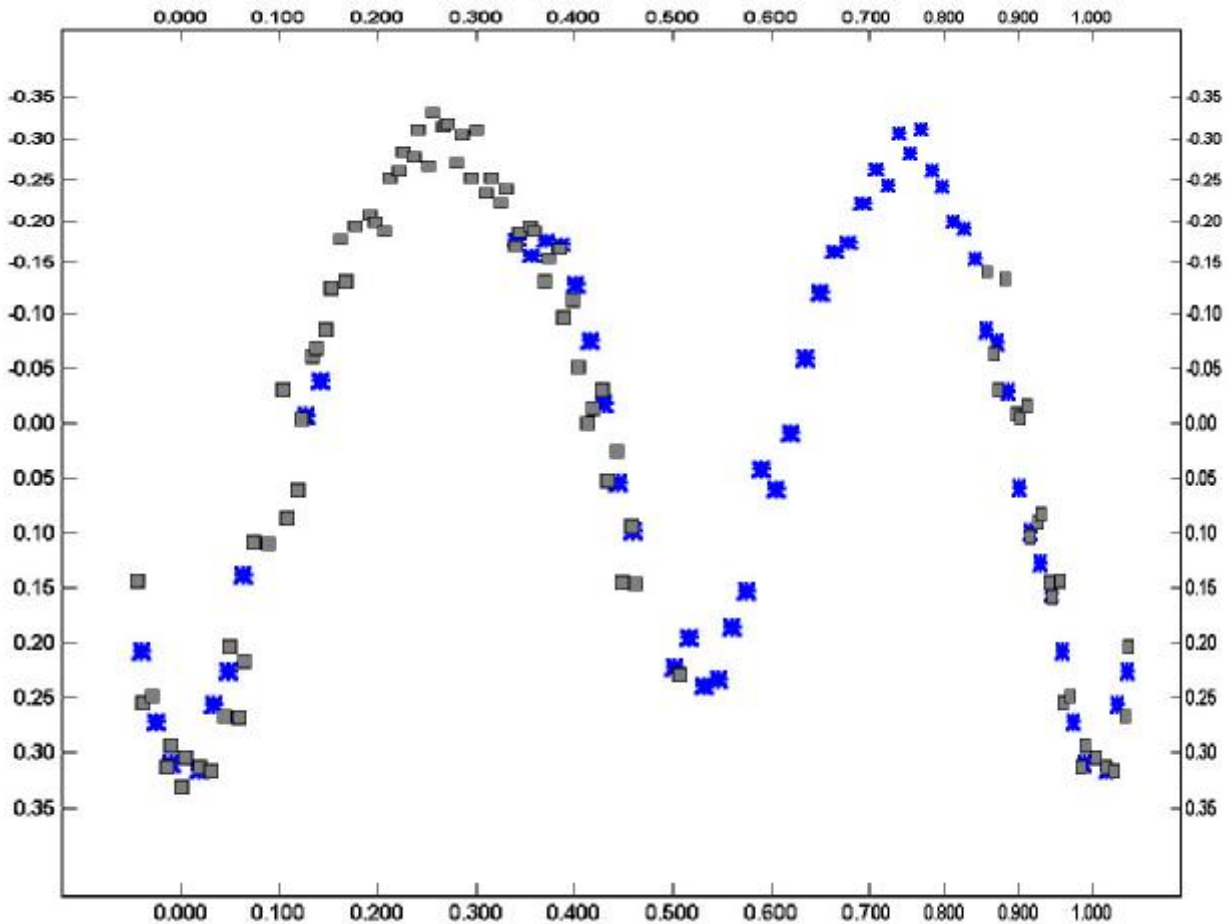


# (3678) Mongmanwai

Notes: Mongmanwai was discovered on January 20, 1966 at the Purple Mountain Observatory at Nanking. It is named in honor of Man Wai Mong who was prominent in the Chinese electrical engineering community. It is a member of the Marias Family. Based upon its H value Mongmanwai is presumed to be 28km in diameter.
