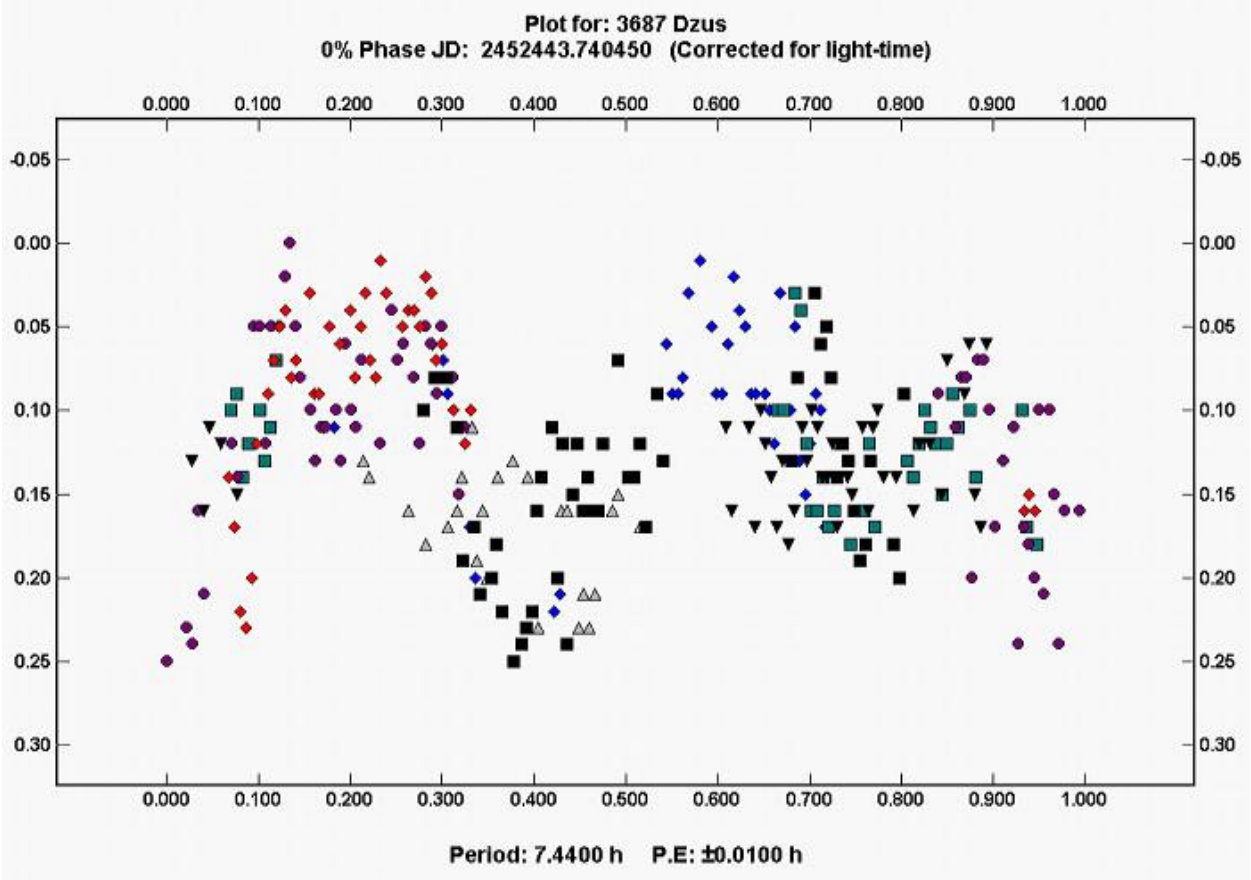

Notes: 3687 Dzus is a main-belt asteroid discovered by A. Kopff at Heidelberg on October 7, 1908. It is named in honor of Paul Dzus in appreciation of his helpful assistance at the Minor Planet Center, much of the time as a volunteer. There are notches in each primary that repeat over several sessions.
