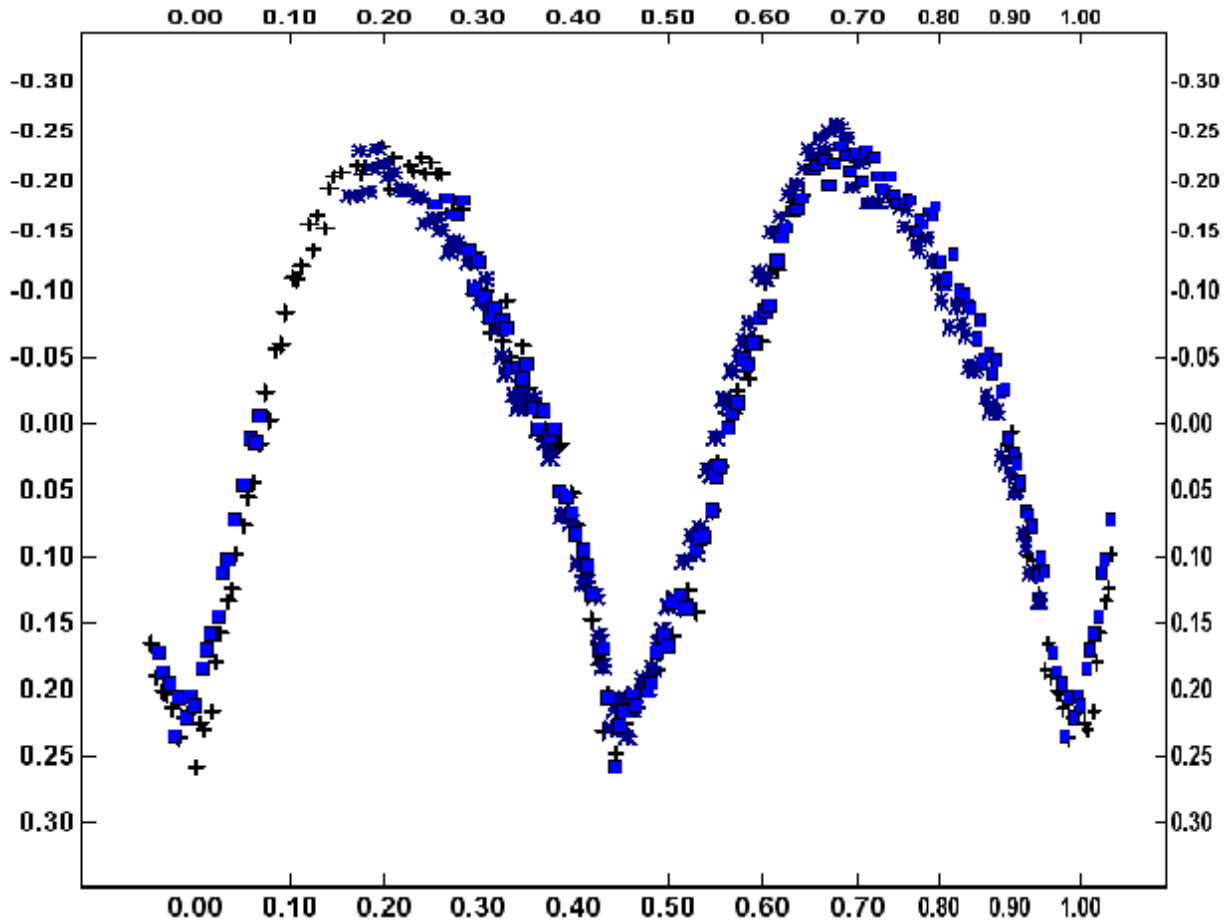

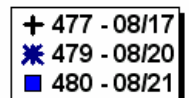

Notes: Jetta is a Marias Family asteroid discovered on September 11, 1904 by P. Götz at Heidelberg. It is named for the site on which the Heidelberg castle was built in the 15<sup>th</sup> century. Jetta is estimated to be 12km in diameter.
