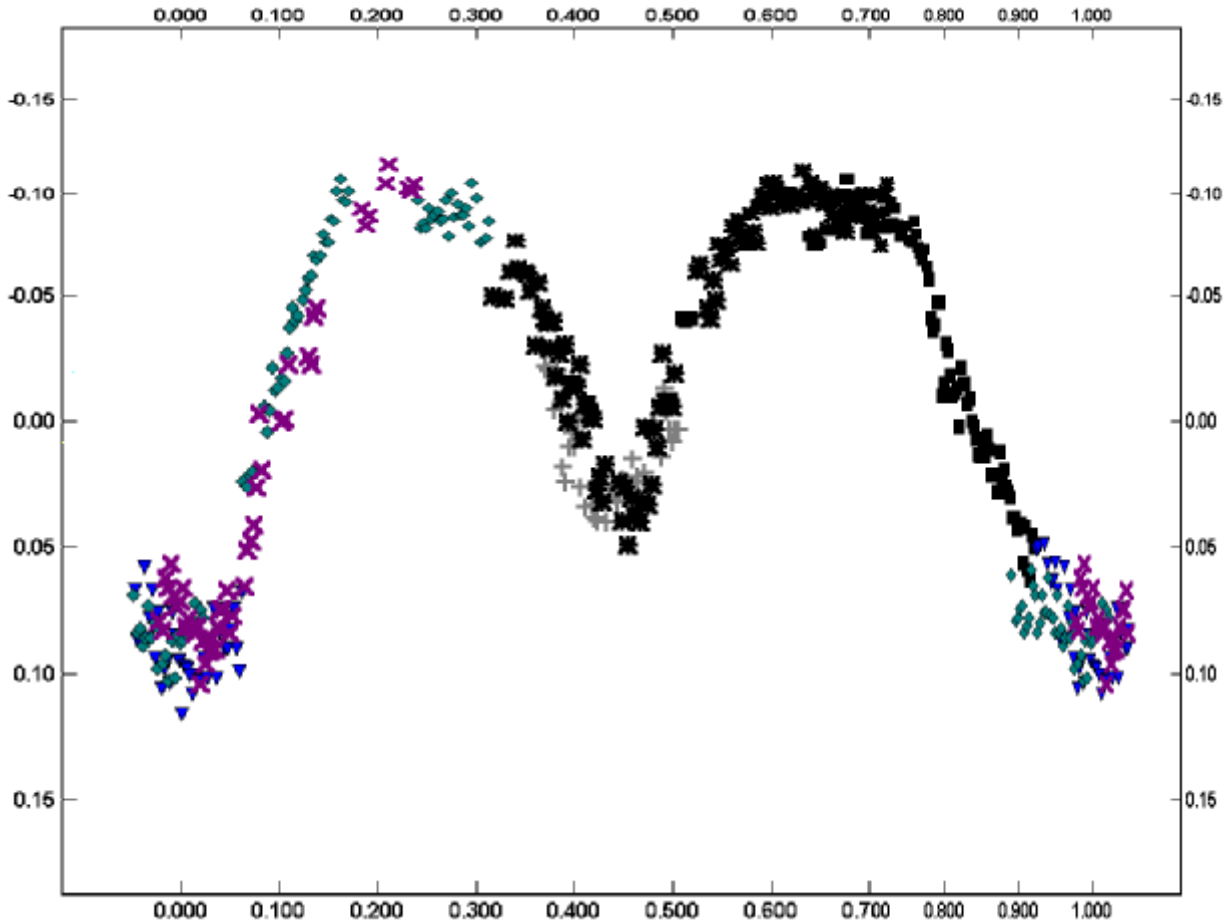

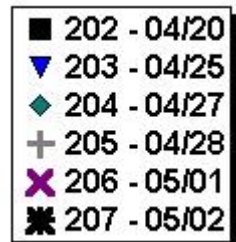

Notes: Christine was discovered on 1907 March 7 by A. Kopff at Heidelberg. It is a member of the Marias Family and is 25 km in diameter. There is no known reference to the name Christine. The period was previously reported by Schober as greater than 14 hours in Astronomy and Astrophysics, 1981, Volume 100, 311-313.
