

TIMELINE OF D'NI HISTORY

This worksheet is based on the timeline in the D'niPedia Archive at <http://www.dpwr.net/>. It has been modified to present new converted dates, and by the addition of events from additional sources (highlighted in blue letters), such as the DRC notebooks in Uru: Complete Chronicles. Extensive annotations have also been added, including date sources and cell comments.

Dates sourced from riven.com are from the original D'ni timeline provided by Cyan, and are unquestionably official. Dates sourced from Cyan-produced games, the DRC Web site, or RAWA are also considered trustworthy. Dates sourced from non-Cyan Myst games, or estimated from information in the three Myst novels are more suspect. The original source of dates attributed to myst5.com is uncertain, though a number of them are probably estimated from BoT.

An asterisk (*) in the flags column indicates that the date has not been confirmed by an official source. An exclamation point (!) in the flags column indicates the presence of an annotation (cell comment).

If only a hahr (year) is known, the vailee and yahr (month and day) used to calculate the converted date are shown in red letters. Normally a mid-hahr or mid-year date is used, unless there is additional information on the time frame, such as an indication that the event is early in the year.
