Generation One

1. Lt. Thomas¹ Leffingwell; born between 1622 and 1624 in England; It is thought he was a native of Croxhall/Coggeshall, England;¹² married Mary White? before 1648? in Saybrook, Middlesex Co., CT;^{3,4} died 1714 in Saybrook, Middlesex Co., CT.^{5,6,7}

He immigrated circa 1637 to New England from England. He brought with him a silver-headed cane bearing the initials T.L. This cane was in the possession of his 4ggson, Nathaniel Shipman, who was living in, in July 1853.⁸ He was residing in 1637 in Saybrook, Middlesex Co., CT: one of the earliest planters of Saybrook.^{9,10,11} "In 1645, he appears to have rendered valuable assistance to Uncas, the Mohegan Sachem, when the latter was beseiged by the Narraganett Indians. [Burke] "...in the spring of 1646, with a few associates rendered such timely aid to Uncas, when besieged by the Naragansets, and reduced to the last extremity by famine. He had the address, though at great hazard, to enter Pequot river in the night, with a boat laden with provisions from Saybrook, and to deposit them in the fort on Shantok Point, undiscovered by the enemy." [NEHGR 8].^{12,13,14} He was residing in 1660 in Norwich, New London Co., CT: one of the first settlers, his name is on Uncas Monument, and he is listed in the Town of Norwich Patent of 1685.^{15,16} Office(s) held: Deputy, 1661-1710.¹⁷ Military: "appointed a Lieutenant, 1672, and served in King Philip's War".¹⁸

Mary White? died on 6 Feb 1710/11 in Norwich, New London Co., CT.^{19,20}

2. Rachel² Leffingwell (*Thomas¹*); born 17 Mar 1648 in Saybrook, Middlesex Co., CT;^{27,28,29,30} married Robert Parke, son of Thomas Parke and Dorothy Thompson, 24 Nov 1681 in Norwich, New London Co., CT;^{31,32,33,34} died circa 1693 in Norwich, New London Co., CT.³⁵

Robert Parke/Parks, was born in 1651 in New London, New London Co., CT.^{36,37} He married Mary Rose circa 1693?³⁸ He died in 1707 in Stonington, New London Co., CT.^{39,40}
