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Preface

My WHITEHOUSE interest stems from my maternal grandfather - Bert Winfred⁵ Whitehouse. His father was a stepson of Fielder³ Whitehouse and his mother was a direct line WHITEHOUSE. His father, Thomas Henry⁴ Whitehouse, was stepson of Fielder³ Whitehouse and natural son of Bridget (Ryan) Whitehouse. His mother, Ada Ann⁴ (Whitehouse) Whitehouse, was daughter of Daniel³ and Almira Ann (Barrows/Burrus) Whitehouse. Fielder³ and Daniel³ were brothers - sons of Chester² and Chloe (--?--) Whitehouse.

At this time, I have only traced these WHITEHOUSES back to Thomas¹ and Anna (--?--) Whitehouse who first appear in Mansfield, CT, church records when 4 of their children were baptized on 6 October 1799. I have not found where they or their children were born, where they were married, or where they died. I suspect, with no proof, Thomas¹ was a descendant of the early New England WHITEHOUSE family of whom many of its descendants migrated from MA to NH in the 1600s. The given name of Thomas is very common in that WHITEHOUSE line. If you have information on the ancestry of Thomas¹ and Anna (--?--) WHITEHOUSE, I'd love to hear from you.

Special thanks to Russell E. Pawlak for supplying me with photocopies of Fielder³, Edmond³ and Storrs³ Whitehouses' Civil War Records, Fielder³ Whitehouse's Probate Records, and the Ledger of Whitehouse and Balch Family Records compiled by Ernest J.⁵ Whitehouse (1895-1970). These valuable resources allowed me to piece together many families of WHITEHOUSE descendants. Many thanks to Dorothy⁶ Whitehouse Gascoigne for her family reminiscences and to Grace⁷ Whitehouse Scott for piquing my WHITEHOUSE interest. I am very grateful to the staff of the Ashford Town Clerk's Office for their help and patience.

Hopefully in the next few years I'll be able to push back the ancestry of these WHITEHOUSES to their progenitor-immigrant. At that time I will update this published report. Please, do not ask me for any other WHITEHOUSE information. The only WHITEHOUSE genealogy data I have is in this report. - 5 iv. Daniel WHITEHOUSE; baptized 6 Oct 1799 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT (baptized on same as siblings: Thomas, Betsey, Chester, Horace and Abigail).⁸
- 6 v. Horace WHITEHOUSE; baptized 6 Oct 1799 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT (baptized on same day as siblings: Thomas, Betsey, Chester, Daniel, and Abigail).⁹
- 7 vi. Abigail WHITEHOUSE; baptized 6 Oct 1799 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT (baptized on same day as siblings: Thomas, Betsey, Chester, Daniel and Horace).¹⁰
- 8 vii. Samuel Stowel WHITEHOUSE; baptized 19 Apr 1801 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT.¹¹
- 9viii. Mary Ann WHITEHOUSE; baptized 1 Sep 1805 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT;¹² married Hiram SMITH 26 Nov 1827 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT.^{13/14/15/16} Not sure she was a daughter of Thomas and Anna WHITEHOUSE for her baptism reads "Theo. and Anne Whitehouse." As there is no other listing for a Theo. and Anne in the published VRs of Mansfield, I'm assuming her parents were Thomas and Anna.
- 10 ix. James WHITEHOUSE; baptized 23 Apr 1809 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT.¹⁷
- 11 x. Sarah Sanford WHITEHOUSE; baptized 27 May 1810 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT;¹⁸ married Allmet WILLIAMS 25 Nov 1827 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT (Rev. Ezekiel Skinner officiated).^{19/20/21/22}

Generation Two

4. Chester² WHITEHOUSE (Thomas¹); born between 1790 and 1799 (The censuses of 1820-1850 indicate the earliest he could have been born was 1790 and he was baptized in 1799);^{23 / 24 / 25 / 26} baptized 6 Oct 1799 in Second Church, Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT (baptized on same day as siblings: Thomas, Betsey, Daniel, Horace and Abigail);²⁷ married Chloe (--?--);²⁸ died Apr 1848 in Ashford, Windham CO., CT.^{29 / 30 / 31}

He was residing between 1820 and 1850 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT.^{32 / 33 / 34}

Chloe (--?--) was born circa 1795 in CT.^{35 / 36 / 37} Research on Chloe has turned up some puzzling conflicts/questions. Did Chloe marry a Nathan SQUIRE in 1854 or did she die in Ashford as Chloe WHITEHOUSE in 1862? (1) Calculating her date of birth from 1850 and 1860 censuses it appears she was born c1794 to c1796 respectively. (2) A death record, 9:19, in the Town Records of Ashford has a Chloe WHITEHOUSE (single) dying in Oct 1862 at the age of 63, which calculates to a date of birth of c1799. (3) The Town Records of Ashford has a marriage record, 8:5 and 6:111, for a Chloe WHITEHOUSE (age 60, 2nd marriage) of Mansfield to a Nathan SQUIRE (age 64, 2nd marriage) of Ashford on Nov. 12, 1854. Age 60 in 1854 means she was born c1794. (4) In the 1860 census she was residing in the household of her daughter, Mary Ann Whitehouse Brown, which means she couldn't have married a SQUIRE and retained the surname WHITEHOUSE in the census.^{38 / 39 / 40} She was residing with the family of her daughter Mary Ann Whitehouse BROWN on 29 Jun 1860 in Ellington, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.⁴¹ She died in Oct 1862 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT (cause: cancer of womb).⁴²

Known children of Chester² WHITEHOUSE and Chloe (--?--) were as follows:

- + 12 i. Daniel³ WHITEHOUSE, born circa 1816 in CT; married Almira Ann BARROWS.
- 13 ii. Storrs WHITEHOUSE; born circa 1823 in CT;⁴³ married Julia E. WILSON 1862 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT;^{44 / 45} died before 16 Feb 1898.⁴⁶ I'm not sure Storrs, son of Chester & Chloe who md in 1862 Julia Wilson, is the same Storrs who enlisted in 1862 in the CW. Reasons: (1) Storrs, son of Chester, md 3 Sep 1862 Julia in Ashford. Storrs, in the CW, enlisted the day before, 2 Sep 1862, in Mansfield and 3 days later on 5 Sep 1862 was muster-in at Camp Norton, Norwich, CT. Would Storrs have had time to enlist in Mansfield on the 2nd, marry in Ashford on the 3rd and be muster-in at Norwich on the 5th? (2) Storrs, son of Chester, was born c1823 per the 1850 census. The Storrs, in the CW, was born c1825 per his CW records, "Company Muster-in Roll." (3) However, do note, his description on mustering-in was described the same as for his brother Fielder: dark complexion, eyes and hair. His brother Edmond was described as having dark eyes and hair too but with fair complexion. Also both he and his brother Fielder enrolled on the same date, 2 Sep 1862, yet in different towns

and both muster-in on 5 Sep 1862 into the same company at Camp Norton, Norwich, CT. (See military info for the 3 brothers). Occupation: laborer on 27 Jul 1850 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT.⁴⁷ Military: (Civil War: Enrolled 2 Sep 1862, Mansfield, CT; Muster-in 5 Sep 1862 Camp Norton, Norwich, CT, into "Company D 21st Regt. Conn Infantry as private." He was honorably discharged at Richmond, VA, on 16 Jun 1865. A "Company Description Book," 2 Sep 1862, describes him as 37 yrs, 5' 8," with dark complexion, eyes, and hair. On 11 Dec 1863, he was detached as Harbor Police at Norfolk VA and in July and Aug 1864 he was detached to the Sharp Shooters Corps, 1st Div).^{48, 49}

- 14 iii. Sanford WHITEHOUSE; born circa 1824 in Ashford, Windham, CT;^{50, 51} died 22 Jan 1851 in Willington, Tolland Co., CT.⁵² Occupation: laborer on 27 Jul 1850 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT.⁵³
- + 15 iv. Fielder WHITEHOUSE, born May 1825 in Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT; married Bridget RYAN.
- + 16 v. Mary Ann WHITEHOUSE, born circa 1831 in CT; married Alfred BROWN.
- + 17 vi. Edmond WHITEHOUSE, born 21 Mar 1835 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT; married Bridget MCLAUGHLIN.

Generation Three

12. Daniel³ WHITEHOUSE (Chester², Thomas¹); born circa 1816 in CT;^{54, 55} married Almira Ann BARROWS, daughter of Elisha BARROWS Jr. and Hannah SQUIRE, 29 Nov 1839 in Farmington, Hartford Co., CT (Rev. Ezra S. Cook officiated);^{56, 57, 58} died 25 Aug 1897 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT (cause: "General debility stricture").⁵⁹

Occupation: farmer in 1860 in Ellington, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.^{60, 61}

Almira Ann Barrows aka BURRUS; was born on 30 Sep 1822 in Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT.^{62, 63, 64, 65} She died on 23 May 1881 in Ashford, Windham CO., CT, at age 58.⁶⁶

Known children of Daniel³ WHITEHOUSE and Almira Ann BARROWS were as follows:

15. Fielder³ WHITEHOUSE (Chester², Thomas¹); born May 1825 in Mansfield, Tolland Co., CT;^{67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72} married Bridget RYAN 9 Aug 1856 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT (Rev. G.B. Margot officiated);^{73, 74, 75} died 27 Feb 1903 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, at age 77 (cause: Heart disease);^{76, 77, 78, 79, 80} buried in Snow (Warrenville) Cemetery, Ashford, Windham Co., CT;⁸¹ his estate was probated 12 Dec 1904 in Probate Court, District of

Ashford, CT (son James R. appointed administrator of his estate, he died intestate, own real estate in the Town of Ashford).⁸²

There are questions concerning Fielder: (1) Spouse: Was his wife's given name Cordelia or Bridget? Cordelia - A marriage recorded in Ashford 9 Aug 1856 has Fielder WHITEHOUSE age 30 md to Cordelia RYAN age 22. The census of 1860 has his wife's name as Cordelia. Birth records of their twin sons Edwin and Edward have the mother's name as Cordelia. Bridget - A marriage recorded in Willington 1 Sep 1860 has a Fielder WHITEHOUSE md to Bridget RYAN. Fielder says in his pension records of 1894 that his wife was Bridget Ryan md Aug 1856. The 8 other children mother's name is Bridget per birth records or/and Pension records. The death certificate of his stepson Thomas WHITEHOUSE has mother as Bridget RYAN - no father listed. There is a death recorded in Ashford for Bridget WHITEHOUSE in 1901. (2) Stepson: Did Fielder legally adopt Thomas Henry, the son of his wife Bridget RYAN, or did Thomas assume the name because he lived with Fielder since age of 3. All of Thomas' official papers have his name as Thomas WHITEHOUSE. Fielder is buried in the same row/line as Thomas' family. However, Fielder did not list Thomas as a living child of his in his Pension records of 1894 and Thomas was still alive. If Fielder had legally adopted Thomas would he have listed Thomas with his other children? Fielder made no mention of Thomas in his will. (3) Were there 2 Fielder WHITEHOUSES in Windham County at the same time with both marrying RYAN women? The Windham County census of 1850 has two Fielder WHITEHOUSES. One living in the household of the jailer in Brooklyn and another living in the household of Chloe Whitehouse in Ashford. Could both of them have married a RYAN? If there were 2 Fielders, which one was the stepfather of Thomas, which one married Bridget, which one is buried in the Warrenville cemetery near Thomas, which one was living in the household of Chloe, etc? If the 2 Fielders in the 1850 census weren't so close in age (23 and 24) then many of these questions could be easily resolved.

Occupation: laborer in 1850 in Windham Co., CT.^{83, 84} Military: (Civil War: Private, Co. D. 21 Regiment, Connecticut Volunteers, Infantry. He "enrolled" 2 Sep 1862 in Willington, CT, muster-in 5 Sep 1862 at Camp Norton, Norwich, CT, and "honorably discharged at New Haven, Conn, on the 6 day of August, 1865." A "Company Descriptive booklet" describes him as age 39, 6" with dark complexion, eyes and hair: ["Captured at Fort Harrison, Va., Sept. 29, '64, was confined at Richmond, Va., Sept. 30, '64, paroled at Varina, Va, Oct., 8, '64. reported at Co. G Bks. Md, Oct. 10, '64, sent to Camp Parole, Md, Oct 11, '64, furloughed for 15 days, Oct 31, '64 and deserts Nov. 14, '64. This charge of desertion is reverse, he was absent without leave from Nov. 14, '64 to Dec. 19, '64 when he was arrested at Hartford, Conn. delivered same day at --- Rendezvous, New Haven, Conn. and forwarded to Regt. Dec., 25, '64, which he joined Jan 1, '65." In "March 1864 at or near Little Washington, State of North Carolina, said Fielder Whitehouse was disabled in the line of his duty by a sudden attack of Pleurisy and was sent to Hospital at Little Washington and remained there

about one month went with Regiment to Portsmouth and from there was sent to Blackwells Island New York."]).^{85 / 86 / 87} An inventory of his estate was declared on 15 Sep 1903 in Probate Court, District of Ashford, Windham Co., CT, by his son James R. [Inventory: "1 house and 2 kinds Land: \$40.00, 10 Acres of Sprout Land \$35.00"- \$75.00, Amount received in credit: \$75.00; Costs: casket \$36.50, Publishing notice \$2.00, Appraisers \$2.00, Paid D.A. Baker's claim \$13.00, Probate fee \$12.00, Administrators fee \$9.50; remainder: \$75.00] .⁸⁸

Bridget Ryan aka Cordelia; was born on 10 Oct 1834 in Ireland.⁸⁹ I have found conflicting data on her given name - Bridget/Cordelia. Her marriage record (1856) in Ashford, one census, and birth records of her twin sons Edward and Edwin have her as Cordelia. Another census, her death record, her son Thomas' death record, records of the rest of her children, her husband's pension records, and a marriage record in 1860 for a Fielder and Bridget in Willington all say Bridget. On all the records her surname reads either RYAN or REGAN. The handwriting on these documents slurs the 2nd letter making it sometimes impossible to read. (See text under her son Thomas for more detail.) She died on 14 Aug 1901 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, at age 66 (cause: "Acute Dysentery").⁹⁰

- 16. Mary Ann³ WHITEHOUSE (Chester², Thomas¹); born circa 1831 in CT;^{109 / 110} married Alfred BROWN before 1858.¹¹¹

Alfred Brown was born circa 1832 in CT.¹¹² Occupation: farmer on 29 Jun 1860 in Ellington, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.¹¹³

Edmond³ WHITEHOUSE (*Chester², Thomas¹*) aka Edmund; born 21 Mar 1835 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT;^{115, 116, 117, 118} married Bridget MCLAUGHLIN Dec 1855 (Elder George Chamberlain officiated);^{119, 120, 121} died 11 Dec 1912 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, at age 77;¹²² buried in Warrenville Cemetery, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.¹²³

Occupation: farmer.¹²⁴ Military: (Civil War: Private Co. D. 21 Regiment, Connecticut Volunteers Infantry: He was "enrolled" in the service on 17 Dec 1863 at Norwich, CT, and was honorably discharged at Hartford, CT, on 14 Jun 1865. He is described on a Furlough Leave form, 25 May 1865 and in his pension records as, 6' 2" with fair complexion and dark eyes and hair).^{125, 126, 127, 128} He moved from Ashford, Windham Co., to Mansfield, Tolland Co., c1908.¹²⁹

Bridget McLaughlin was born in Nov 1834 in Ireland.^{130, 131} She died on 23 Dec 1886 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, at age 52 (cause: cancer of the womb).^{132, 133, 134} She was buried in Warrenville Cemetery, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.¹³⁵

Known children of Edmond³ WHITEHOUSE and Bridget MCLAUGHLIN were as follows:

18. Ellen⁴ WHITEHOUSE (*Daniel³, Chester², Thomas¹*); born before 1852;¹⁴⁴ married Herbert HANOVER.¹⁴⁵

Ellen was the older sister of Ann. Ann's son Bert and Ellen's son Walter were good friends. Many times in the 1920s and early 30s Bert would take his family and his mother to Groton, CT, to visit.¹⁴⁶

Herbert Hanover was a building contractor. His son Walter followed him in the business.¹⁴⁷

Known children of Ellen⁴ WHITEHOUSE and Herbert HANOVER were as follows:

+ 38 ii. Walter HANOVER, born circa 1874; married Maud (--?--).

19. Ada Ann⁴ WHITEHOUSE (*Daniel³, Chester², Thomas¹*); born 17 Jan 1852 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT;^{149, 150, 151, 152} married Thomas Henry WHITEHOUSE [see Number 20], son of Fielder WHITEHOUSE [see Number 15] and Bridget RYAN, 2 Feb 1874 in Willimantic, CT. (per Windham Marriages, Vol. J, p. 38).

Ada and Thomas were step-cousins through his step-father Fielder Whitehouse);^{153, 154} died 6 Mar 1936 in Pomfret, Windham Co., CT, at age 84 (cause of death: Carcinoma of uterine cervix, Dr. Wm. Mac Shepard, Place of death: Pomfret, Residence of death: Warrenville. [She was living with her unmarried son George when she became very ill. She was brought to her son Bert's house in Pomfret where she could be looked after by his wife Abigail and a day nurse in her final days.]);^{155, 156, 157} buried in Warrenville Cemetery, Ashford, Windham Co., CT (Her funeral was at the Warrenville Baptist Church, Ashford, CT.).^{158, 159}

Ada Ann had piano or organ lessons when young. She could read music and play with both hands.¹⁶⁰ Occupation: teacher circa 1870.¹⁶¹ She was residing in the "el" of her son Bert's house between 1914 and 1919 in Pomfret, Windham Co., CT.¹⁶² She moved circa 1920 into a house south of the Abington Congregational Church provided by her son Bert in Pomfret, Windham Co., CT.¹⁶³ She moved circa 1930 in with her unmarried son George who had a chicken farm.¹⁶⁴

Thomas Henry Whitehouse [see Number 21 for more details], nickname "Tommy;" was born probably illegitimate on 8 Jan 1853 in Albany, NY.^{165, 166} He was educated at Ashford Grade School and Woodstock Academy, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT, circa 1868.¹⁶⁷ Occupation: sawmill owner, lumberman, and farmer. Office(s): (State legislator for several terms, probably in the 1890s?).¹⁶⁸ He died on 17 Mar 1907 in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, at age 54 (Cause on death certificate: "Dititation of stomach," G.E. Wilcox, MD).^{169, 170} He was buried in Warrenville Cemetery, Ashford, Windham Co., CT.¹⁷¹

Known children of Ada Ann⁴ WHITEHOUSE and Thomas Henry WHITEHOUSE all born in Ashford, Windham Co., CT, were as follows:

Speculation by some family members has been that Thomas was an illegitimate son born to Bridget. According to the Ashford, CT, census of 1860, Fielder's pension records and his mother's marriage record in Ashford, she married Fielder WHITEHOUSE in 1856 as her 1st marriage. Thomas, her son, was born in 1853. According to Thomas' death record and the birth record of his son Bert, he was born in Albany, NY, with mother's name Bridget RYAN/REGAN - no father's name listed. Fielder WHITEHOUSE's pension records do not list Thomas under his living children. It was common knowledge in his son's, Bert WHITEHOUSE, family that Fielder WHITEHOUSE was not Thomas' natural father. Whether Thomas assumed the surname WHITEHOUSE or was officially adopted by Fielder is not known. The Town Clerk of Ashford refused to give me any such information. She refused to even look or to give advise on how to obtain such information even after I told her it was over 100 yrs. ago and no one involved was still alive. It seems if Fielder had legally adopted Thomas than Thomas would have been listed as one of his children in his pension records. A point of interest involving Thomas which may point to his father, he was the only child in his family to have the privilege of going to boarding school - Woodstock Academy. The other WHITEHOUSE children had some grade school education at the local

school in Ashford but Thomas went on and finished high school. The question that has puzzled us was where did the money come from? Did Thomas possibly have a legacy from a natural father?.

He was educated at Ashford Grade School and Woodstock Academy, Woodstock, Windham Co., CT, circa 1868.²⁰⁵ Occupation: sawmill owner, lumberman, and farmer. In the 1870s, '80s and probably into the '90s, he attended the 4th of July celebrations in Woodstock. Usually he took his wife and oldest son, Bert. They left home before daybreak, took plenty of food and returned after dark. The celebrations included speeches and lectures by famous visiting politicians, philosophers, and writers; picnics at Roseland Park with swimming and water show; and the fireworks.²⁰⁶
