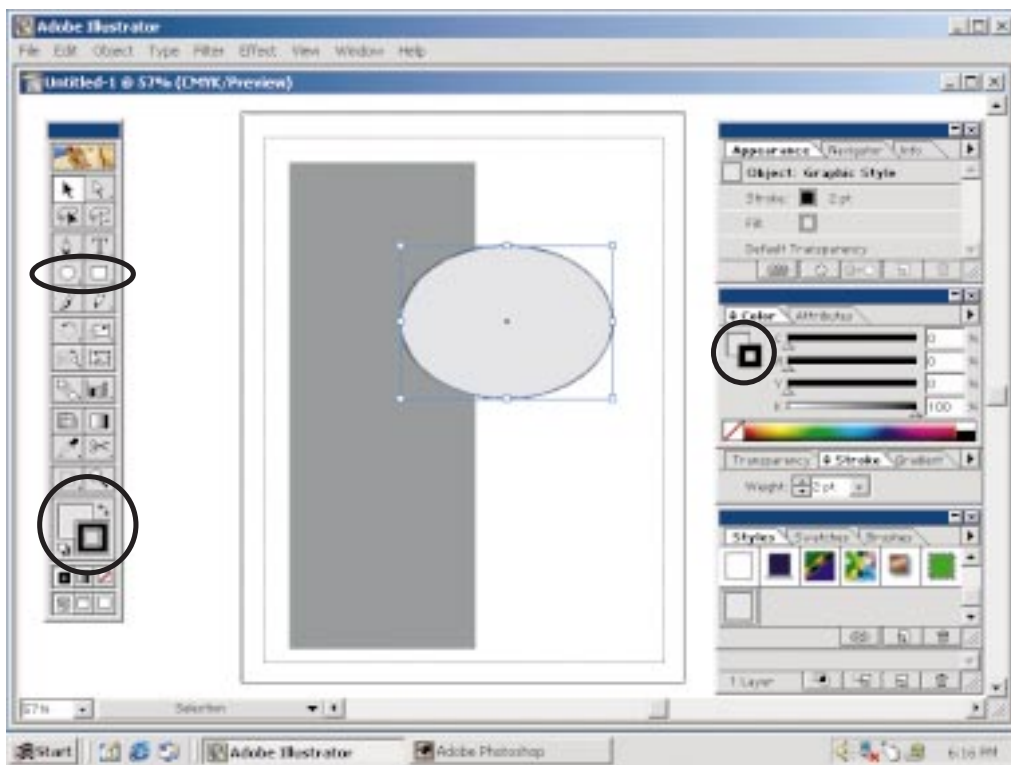


## Adobe Illustrator

- Using ONLY the SHAPE tools (circle, square, polygon star and spiral) to create a drawing.



### Using the shape tools:

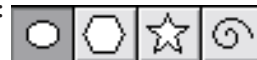
Click and drag from one corner diagonally (i.e. click in upper left, and drag to lower right) to draw a shape.

Holding down the SHIFT key makes a perfect square or circle.

Holding down the OPTION key draws the shape from the center.

SHIFT+OPTION gives you a perfect shape, from the center.

Look behind the CIRCLE tool (click and hold on the circle in the toolbar) to reveal the other polygon shape tools:



### To color your shapes:

Select (with the BLACK ARROW) the shape whose color you want to change.

Click on either the FILL or LINE color on the toolbar (circled above) or the COLOR palette, to change either the shape's fill color or outline color.

Then click on the color you want in the little rainbow in the COLOR palette.

Changing a fill or line color with NOTHING selected changes the default color for the next shape you draw.



### Using the Paintbrush tool

You may also use the PAINTBRUSH tool.

Use the BRUSHES PALETTE to change the direction and size of the stroke. Notice an un-closed shape looks like it is filled in between the gaps (see shapes to right->).

Select the FILL color on the menu bar (at left) and click on the little NO "/" symbol
