

## What have we Achieved in 2003?

With very little funding, we have accomplished a tremendous amount including:

- Conducted a survey of island residents to better understand water front related issues
- Met with the head of the Storm Water Department and came to an agreement on next steps in addressing the clogged culvert running beneath the airport and related canal sedimentation
- Met with Tampa Bay Watch and "kicked off" a research effort as the first step in planning an artificial reef project for 2005
- Met with legal advisors representing the concerns of similar civic organization
- Established a website and produced our first Newsletter.
- Coordinated efforts with Civic Association leaders.

With all that we have started, real progress can only be made with a broad base of residents supporting our efforts.. We look forward to your help and support in 2004.
