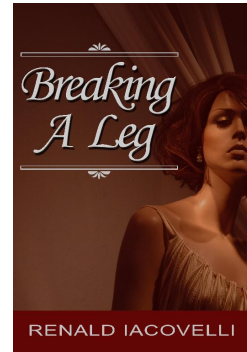

He lived in New York City for four years before moving West.
