

RETAINER AGREEMENT FOR MARIANNE INOUYE

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC requires a \$1,500, \$2,500, or \$3,500 non-refundable and non-transferable retainer (see fee schedule), a signed retainer agreement, and all necessary and pertinent documents before work commences.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC requires a \$300 non-refundable designation fee payable prior to the designation of Marianne Inouye as your expert witness (which is applied against the non-refundable retainer should work commence).

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC bills for its services on an hourly basis. Rates are \$200 to \$250 per hour for document review, research, valuation, travel and on-call time; and \$300 per hour for deposition, arbitration and trial testimony. Reimbursable expenses will be billed as incurred.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC is retained by the attorney and their firm, not their client.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC will bill as work is completed or on a monthly basis for work-in-progress; payment is due upon receipt of the ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC invoice and is the direct responsibility of the retaining attorney and firm. Payment is not contingent on the status or outcome of the case and is not dependent upon the retaining firm being paid by their client.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC reserves the right to stop all work or to be unavailable for deposition, arbitration, or trial testimony until the balance on previous billing is brought current.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC reserves the right to be reimbursed for all expenses, attorneys' fees, and costs incurred in connection with debt collections. If any invoice is not paid in full within 60 days of receipt of statement, a ten percent interest rate may accrue on the principal from the due date until paid. If unpaid balance results in litigation, a Pasadena-area venue will be selected based on proximity of where work was performed.

ZENGLER & INOUYE, LLC requires receipt of pertinent information in a timely manner in order to provide meaningful opinions; valuations are prioritized on the basis of court-imposed deadlines.
